

INTRODUCTION AND ACKNOWLEDGEMENTS



Dear Friends,

2024 was a year in which we, as the Orphan Foundation, worked with great enthusiasm and dedication, witnessing many beautiful developments and achievements. Together with you, our valuable volunteers, donors, and colleagues, we were happy to touch the lives of more children.

One of the most significant developments of this year was that our foundation gained tax-exempt status. Pursuant to Article 20 of Law No. 4962, the Orphan Foundation was granted the right to tax exemption with the President's decision dated January 17, 2024. This status will open new doors for us, enabling us to reach a wider audience, implement our

projects more effectively, and create more permanent solutions for orphaned children. We sincerely thank everyone who contributed to this important achievement.

Another major step was moving our headquarters to Kariye. The working areas of our foundation are expanding day by day, and the number of volunteers, donors, and staff is increasing. In order to manage this growth more effectively, to host our volunteers and guests in a larger and more spacious environment, and to conduct interviews with families applying for aid in a more calm and private setting, we have relocated our new headquarters to Kariye. We would like to express our gratitude to Leman Yenigün, Deputy Minister of Family and Social Services, Davut Gül, Governor of Istanbul, and Dr. Abdullah Matuk, President of the Kuwait International Islamic Relief Organization, who joined us at our opening ceremony. We would also like to thank the members of the press and all our guests who attended the ceremony.

In 2024, we had the joy of reaching tens of thousands of people in need during four major campaign periods: Ramadan, Qurban, winter, and education. During Ramadan, we provided our orphaned children with rations, Eid clothes, iftar meals, zakat, fitrah, and ransom support. During Eid al-Adha, we distributed qurbani meat and Eid clothes. During the winter months, we provided warm clothes, fuel, and blankets. And during the education period, we delivered stationery sets, school bags, and books. In total, we reached 2,403,529 people in 35 countries. We have shared the numerical statistics and photos of our activities with you in our report. Regardless of the numbers, the smile of each child and the prayers of each family were priceless to us.

Our emergency humanitarian aid efforts continued unabated in 2024. We raised our voices against the inhumane attacks in Gaza and provided both in-kind and cash aid to our siblings there. We continued to support the victims of the floods in Bangladesh, the attacks in Lebanon, and the civil war in Sudan. After 14 years of massacres and oppression committed by the Assad regime in Syria, we launched a large-scale emergency aid operation in the country following the fall of the regime, delivering 12 trucks of humanitarian aid in the first stage. Wherever there is oppression, wherever there are victims, as the Orphan Foundation, we have strived to do our best and stand by them.

In order to bring attention to the rights of orphaned and motherless children and raise awareness, we also celebrated World Orphans Day on Ramadan 15 and Children's Rights Day on November 20. On Ramadan 15, the Orphan Foundation organized a press statement at the Rami Library under the Children's Rights Platform, drawing attention to the difficulties faced by orphans and oppressed children. We shared the report "Being a Child in Palestine," which we prepared for this special day, with the public. On November 20, Children's Rights Day, we organized a symposium on "Social Orphanhood" at Boğaziçi University to discuss the historical, sociological, legal, and religious aspects of social orphanhood in an academic framework.


On the anniversary of the attack on Gaza, tens of thousands of children gathered in the busiest squares and venues of cities for the "Draw for Palestinian Children" event, which we organized simultaneously in 81 cities. With the rolls and crayons we prepared, they conveyed their messages of support for Palestine and expressed their feelings through their drawings.

In every one of these efforts, there was your support, efforts, and prayers. Without you, we would not have been able to reach so many children, families, and oppressed people. Together with you, we have become a growing family, touching more and more lives every year. In the coming years, we will continue to work with the same determination and effort to reach more orphans, raise their hopes, and beautify the world with the smiles of children. We sincerely thank each and every one of you for walking with us on this journey of goodness.

Under the roof of Esenlik Durakları, we carry out activities aimed at helping individuals feel safe, heal, and participate in society with greater strength.

As of 2024, our psychosocial support, application, and research centers located in four regions-Istanbul, Hatay, Kilis, and Idlib (Syria)-continued their work actively. Our team includes psychologists, social workers, counselors, family counselors, and art instructors, all experts in their fields. Through counseling services, individual and group therapies, psychoeducation, and social support programs, they have stood by countless orphans and their mothers.



We did not limit our efforts to individual support; we also carried out activities aimed at enhancing social interaction. Through institutional visits and hosting delegations, we collaborated with various organizations and stakeholders to help strengthen individuals' social cohesion.

We believe that psychosocial support empowers individuals during times of crisis and fosters social solidarity. With this belief, we have continued-and will continue-our efforts under the name Esenlik Durakları, with determination to take steps toward a healthier, more resilient, and hopeful future together.




2. ORPHAN SPONSORSHIP SUPPORT SYSTEM PROJECT




DISTRIBUTION OF ORPHANS WE SUPPORT IN TÜRKİYE BY **PROVINCE**

Through our interviews, we gather information about the social and economic situation of families and children and provide support based on this information.

In addition to offering psychological support to both adults and children, we also provide in-kind and financial assistance to help them enhance their social functionality, integrate into the communities they live in, cope with their grief, overcome economic hardships, improve their social and economic well-being, and raise their living standards.



6. SUPPORTS FOR ORPHANAGES AND ORPHANS FAMILY SETTLEMENTS

The most important factor for a child's physical and mental well-being is the warmth of a family. However, children who have lost their parents are deprived of this. For this reason, we believe it is invaluable for them to grow up with close relatives such as uncles, aunts, grandparents, and grandmothers, so that they do not feel alone.

Wars, natural disasters, illness, or poverty can separate children from their families and relatives. In such cases, orphanages or orphan settlements play a crucial role. As the Orphan Foundation, we are doing everything in our power to ensure that these children are not left alone and, at the very least, feel the warmth of a home.

We view orphanages as centers of love, compassion, and mercy, not just places of shelter. We ensure that our children's basic needs—such as education, health, food, shelter, and security—are met, and we develop projects that allow them to grow up in a nurturing environment. Additionally, we provide all forms of administrative and material support to orphanages registered in our system, helping them offer services under better conditions. We believe every child deserves to grow up in safety, with love and hope.

At the same time, we don't see orphanages merely as places of shelter; we also implement projects that bring smiles to our children's faces and warm their hearts. To improve the living conditions of our orphaned children, we make repairs, provide food support, distribute books, organize festivals, and offer visits whenever necessary, ensuring they never feel alone.





7. İYİLİK GEMİSİ PROJECT

İyilik Gemisi, which we started in Reyhanlı, Hatay, and which Syrian mothers and volunteers of the Orphan Foundation have nurtured with love, has been giving hope to children and their families since 2019. The textile design workshop, established to help our orphans' mothers hold on to life with greater strength, has transformed into a healing space where we work together to erase the traces of war while supporting them in standing on their own feet.

In 2024, 17 mothers of orphans, who are veterans of *İyilik Gemisi*, produced 436 pieces of clothing in our textile and handicraft workshop, and 481 amigurumi toys in our visual arts workshop. These efforts not only contributed economically to their families but also brought smiles to the faces of our children.



2. ACTIVITIES DURING EID-AL-ADHA

As the Orphan Foundation, we set out to give hope to orphans and their families in need with the slogan "I Love Your Smile (Gülüşüne Kurban)" as part of our winter projects for 2024. In order to bring blessings to the tables of our oppressed and victimized siblings in different parts of the world, we successfully carried out our qurbani slaughter operations in 24 countries.

We planned our qurbani slaughters by considering the needs of orphaned children and their families living in regions affected by war, poverty, and natural disasters. Our goal was not only to deliver the qurbani meat but also to strengthen the feelings of kindness, solidarity, and brotherhood in the hearts of orphans.





3. ACTIVITIES **DURING** WINTER

In 2024, we launched our campaign in 15 countries with the slogan "Cold Does Not Affect Warm Love." We prepared our orphaned children and their families for winter. In this context, we distributed winter clothes, fuel, stoves, beds, and blankets to ensure they could spend the winter in a warmer and safer environment.

The countries where we carried out our winter projects include: Türkiye, Palestine, Iran, Iraq, Yemen, Syria, and Lebanon in the Middle East; Sudan and Tunisia in Africa; Albania and North Macedonia in the Balkans; and Arakan, Bangladesh, India, and Nepal in South and Southeast Asia.



4. ACTIVITIES DURING EDUCATION

Our activities during the school year, which we define as the "Stationery Project," aim to support orphans, motherless children, abandoned children, and social orphans who are starting the new academic year

by distributing school bags and stationery materials to them. As always, our goal was to bring happiness to new beginnings and to address any deficiencies that might disrupt the educational journey of our children.



We launched our project with the slogan "The Goodness Bell is Ringing," and as part of this initiative, we distributed school bags and stationery to every orphaned child. The stationery included, primarily, bags, pencil cases, pencils, pens, notebooks suitable for various courses, crayons, watercolor paints, pastels, erasers, sharpeners, rulers, and books. Of course, the quantity and variety of materials varied depending on the education system of the country, the age groups of the children, and the budget.





15th OF RAMADAN, **INTERNATIONAL ORPHANS DAY**

One in every four children worldwide is affected by wars, conflicts, and disasters, while one billion children struggle with every aspect of poverty. Approximately 200 million children are forced to work, and half of the 80 million refugees are children.

In 2013, the Organization of Islamic Cooperation declared the 15th day of Ramadan as "World Orphans Day" to draw attention to this painful reality and to pave the way for permanent efforts to support orphaned children. As the Orphan Foundation, we have worked to be the voice of 400 million orphans worldwide with the

press statements we make every year on Ramadan 15.


In Ramadan 2024, we came together under the roof of the Children's Rights Platform, which we formed in partnership with the Orphan Foundation, IHH Humanitarian Relief Foundation, the Lawyers Association and YEÇED. 20th OF NOVEMBER, CHILDREN'S RIGHTS DAY

Every year, as the Orphan Foundation, we observe Children's Rights Day on November 20 with a scientific and academic meeting. This year, we organized the Social Orphanhood Symposium, a first in Türkiye.

The protocol speeches of the symposium, hosted by Boğaziçi University, were delivered by Murat Yılmaz, Chairman of the Board of Directors of the Orphan Foundation; Mustafa Kaya, Deputy Governor of Istanbul; and Mustafa Metin Başbay, Advisor to the Rector of Boğaziçi University. The symposium, which featured the participation of expert academics in their fields, was completed in four separate sessions.



In these sessions, the concept of social orphanhood was discussed from historical, sociological, legal, and religious perspectives. Both internal factors affecting social orphanhood, such as misuse of technology, exposure to violence, neglect and abuse, communication problems, and external factors like wars, migrations, disasters, and the social environment, were discussed in detail.

At the symposium, we also sought answers to questions about how to establish healthy communication with children, how to identify social orphans, and how to combat social issues such as youth suicides and child abuse. Current important issues, such as substance and technology addiction in children, communication breakdown between parents and children, and loneliness, were also addressed, with solutions developed.



7. EMERGENCY HUMANITARIAN AID ACTIVITIES

Humanitarian aid is the greatest pillar of survival in difficult times. While wars, disasters, and crises affect children the most, we have worked with all our strength to stand by them during their hardest moments. In 2024, we mobilized to bring hope to orphans and oppressed children living in crisis regions.

The flood disaster in Bangladesh left thousands of families homeless and created significant difficulties in accessing basic needs. We quickly activated our emergency aid efforts in the flood-affected regions and provided essential rations. We stood by them with food aid to help children struggling with hunger and thirst hold on to life.

The attacks on Gaza since October 7, 2023, have not only destroyed buildings but also the lives of thousands of families. While raising our voice against the genocide committed by Israel against the Palestinian people, we continued our humanitarian aid efforts on the ground. In Gaza, we provided food, hygiene packages, water,

diesel fuel for hospitals, and emergency humanitarian support to reach oppressed children and their families struggling to survive in the midst of war. In this process, where hunger, thirst, and lack of medical supplies are the biggest threats, we worked relentlessly to ensure that life-saving aid reached those in need.




